## DALST BUCHANNAN • THE FIRST MEETING Annotating: annotating is when you read a passage of text closely and add notes or explanations to it in order to develop a deeper understanding of the meaning of the text. We first meet Daisy when Nick (the narrator) goes to have dinner at her house. Below are some extracts from a conversation that Nick and Daisy have on the porch outside her home. As a class, we will discuss these quotations and you can annotate them as we speak about them. "I suppose she talks and- eats, and everything." "Oh, yes." She looked at me absently" "I'm glad it's a girl. And I hope she'll be a fool- that's the best thing a girl can be in this world, a beautiful little fool."
